


Jeff Carrel Les Darons



« Les Darons » (meaning fathers) is a wine which is representative of western Languedoc: the most southern wine region in France, based mainly on Grenache planted on clay and limestone soils.



Appellation: AOP Languedoc

Vintage: 2023

Alcohol: 14.5%

Grape varieties: 70% Grenache / 20% Syrah / 10% Carignan

Terroir: 35% Corbières, 30% Vallée de l'Agly, 20% Clape, 15% Saint-Chinian / Clay and limestone / Mediterranean climate.

Vinification methods: Majority of manuel harvesting, destemmed and crushed, vinified in concrete and stainless steel tanks.

We follow each of the different vinifications, and assemble on each site where the wine is matured.

Maturing: In tanks.

Tasting notes:

This elegant red is beautifully scented with notes of mature strawberries, sweet cherries and raspberries interwoven with generous spices (white pepper).

It is refined and silky on the palate, with a beautiful purity and a frank and charming style.

Pairing:

For everyday cuisine, and the magnum for the weekends...

Recommendations:

Serve between 15 and 18°C

Aging potential: At least 8 years.
